**Special Progress Report  
Lisbon High School  
May 1, 2014**

**The Commission requests that school officials submit a Special Progress Report by May 1, 2014, which provides detailed responses to the following highlighted recommendations:**

1. Confirm the completion of Phase Two to resolve all remaining heating system repair and replacement issues

Classification: *In Progress*

Phase Two is not yet complete. Recently, the Lisbon School Department and Town of Lisbon have entered into a Energy Performance Contract with Siemens Industry, Inc. One element of the contract covers the replacement of the high school's heating and ventilation system. Our plan is to have Siemens Industry include in the guaranteed performance contract, the replacement of existing heating and ventilation units in Lisbon High School over the summer of 2014.

2. Update any additional facilities upgrades or renovations during the current school

Classification: *In Progress*

Lisbon School Department had Siemens Industry replace the heating and ventilation units in the Lisbon High School Guidance Office over the 2014 February Vacation Break.

3. Submit plans, timeline, and allocation of monies to resolve remaining facilities issues identified by the Committee

Classification: *In Progress*

The Lisbon School Department has a bond initiative underway to build a new gymnasium next year. If the town and taxpayers approve the bond all deficiencies found in the current gymnasium will be resolved before the 2015 Accreditation Visit.
