The Committee on Public Secondary Schools, at its October 27-28, 2013 meeting, reviewed the Special Progress Report of Lisbon High School and continued the school's accreditation. While the Committee acknowledges that progress has been made as noted below, until all cited concerns have been satisfactorily resolved the school will remain on probation for the Standards for Accreditation on Instruction and Community Resources for Learning.

The Committee was pleased to commend the progress made on Phase Two of the new heating system including the installation of hot water piping and thermostats throughout the first floor and stubbing expansion of piping to the second floor


The Committee requests that school officials submit an additional Special Progress Report by May 1, 2014 which provides detailed responses to the following highlighted recommendations:

- confirm the completion of Phase Two to resolve all remaining heating system repair and replacement issues
- update any additional facilities upgrades or renovations during the current school year
- submit plans, timeline, and allocation of monies to resolve remaining facilities issues identified by the Committee
